ABSTRACT

The marginalization of rural areas in Zimbabwe in the post-colonial era facilitated the researcher to evaluate on the programs launched by the state and non-state actors in their effort to promote and improve the standards of primary and secondary education from 1980 to 2008 basing in Gokwe rural area. In the first chapter the thesis discuss the efforts done by the state in promoting primary and secondary education, the chapter also covers the constrains or obstacles which hinders the state to successfully achieve her goals. The second chapter tackles upon factors which continued to act as obstacles in hindering the government to achieve its goals and as a result further affected the quality of education attained by learners in the New Millennium era.
